He was previously Manager, Environment & Public Affairs at the International Zinc Association where he had particular responsibility for advancing IZA's sustainable development action plan. He began his career as a Process Engineer in the semi-conductor industry before joining the Zinc Development Association, London as Marketing Executive and later heading the UK Galvanizers Association.
